Wyckoff WTP Electrical Improvements Project Underway

Acworth, GA (06/09/2010) Crowder Construction Company was awarded a construction contract from the Cobb County-Marietta Water Authority (CCMWA) for electrical improvements to the pump station at the Hugh A. Wyckoff Water Treatment Plant in Acworth, Georgia. The pump station, originally constructed in the mid-1980's, is located on Allatoona Lake, and currently houses one 250 HP, two 600 HP and two 1500 pumps. The electrical improvements include providing a new electrical building, emergency generator, new 4160V electrical gear and one new 1500 HP motor for the conversion from a 2400V system to a 4160V system.

Crowder received official notice to proceed on June 9, 2010 and construction is expected to begin in late September 2010. Estimated completion is June 9, 2011.
