CROWDER CIVIL & ENVIRONMENTAL AWARDED EMERGENCY REPAIRS FOR MACON WATER AUTHORITY – CITY OF MACON AND BIBB COUNTY, GA

APEX, NC (10/30/2009) - Crowder Civil & Environmental recently completed emergency repairs to a raw sewage line for the Macon Water Authority. The repair work was located adjacent to the Ocmulgee River in City Central Park in downtown Macon, GA and was a result of recent flooding in the Southeast.

Macon Water Authority contacted the Crowder Civil & Environmental division to repair the damaged line, which consisted of bypassing a 36" force main as well as a 54" main interceptor sewer line. The emergency repairs began September 24, 2009 and included boring and jacking a new 36" force main under the Ocmulgee River levee. The new line was installed and in service on October 9, 2009.

Macon Water Authority has approximately 1,425 miles of water mains and service lines that serve 54,000 metered customers in the City of Macon and surrounding Bibb County area. The sewage collection system operated by the MWA serves over 41,000 customers and includes approximately 250 miles of interceptor sewers and 950 miles of sanitary sewer lines.
