**CROWDER CIVIL & ENVIRONMENTAL AWARDED DESIGN-BUILD GAS TO ENERGY PROJECT
AT THE F. WAYNE HILL WATER RESOURCE CENTER - GWINNETT COUNTY, GA**

APEX, NC (11/01/2009) - The team of Crowder Civil & Environmental and Hazen and Sawyer Environmental Engineers & Scientists has been awarded the design-build gas to energy project at the F. Wayne Hill Water Resource Center (FHWRC).

The green energy, design-build project will be developed to reuse biogas, which is made up of methane generated from the plant's five egg-shaped, anaerobic digesters. The new system will convert biogas to electricity and cogenerate heat for use at the plant. The renewable power will help Gwinnett County Department of Water Resources (DWR) reduce its operation costs at the FHWRC.

The project is being funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). Gwinnett County is one of 2,300 municipalities and organizations in the nation that will share a total of \$3.2 billion in Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grants funded through the ARRA.
